Secretary's reports – Secretary - The secretary reported that the reunion this year was attended by slightly fewer than the previous year but with some new faces attending. As this is also a new hotel and he has received some positive feedback from members. He has purchased a new Rum tub from funds which will be christened this evening along with the tot glasses engraved to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the sinking of the cruiser. He also announced that he was standing down at the AGM this year.
